## SMART Response PE

The SMART Response PE system caters to a broader range of subjects at secondary school level. With this system pupils use a wireless handset with 20 different features allowing them to answer questions using multiple choice functions, in text, or through the numeric buttons for decimals, fractions and even positive and negative numbers.
